Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Basic

Program Description:

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) offers an exciting and challenging healthcare career for individuals interested in providing emergency care in the pre-hospital setting. EMT-Basic licensure qualifies the student for an entry-level position as an emergency care provider with ambulance services, first responder agencies, and other emergency services. EMT-Basics are the cornerstone of EMS in the United States.

The EMT-Basic program is tier entry-level 120 hour training program. Students who successfully complete this program are eligible to take the National Registry of EMTs examination and subsequently apply for state licensure. Note that in addition to the meeting times listed, each student will be required to complete a minimum of 24 hours clinical time with an ambulance service and 8 hours clinical time in the emergency department.

Program Details:

Basic EMTs are taught to systematically evaluate a patient's condition and provide assessment-based treatment. Our program follows the National Standard Curriculum for the Emergency Medical Technician-Basic. The curriculum includes airway management, oxygen therapy, patient assessment, medical emergencies, traumatic injuries, special patient populations, and EMS operations. We teach using interactive online curriculum, classroom lectures, hands-on practical training along with an ambulance and hospital field internship. Students also receive a Professional Rescuer CPR Card from the American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) upon successful completion of the CPR & AED course.

This course meets the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Standard Curriculum for the Emergency Medical Technician training program. This course included CPR and AED training for the professional rescuer according to the American Health and Safety Institute.

Program Prerequisites: 18 years of age or older, HS Diploma or equivalent
